



The Tithing Command

In the book of Malachi chapter 3 and verse 10 we find the following command: *Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in my house, and prove now herewith, saith the Lord of hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.*

That **command** was given to the children of Israel in the promised land. In verses 11 and 12 he gives an example of how this would be accomplished.
